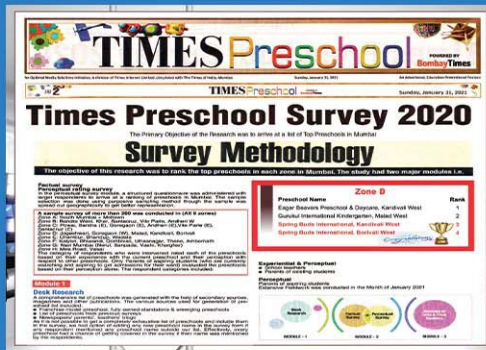

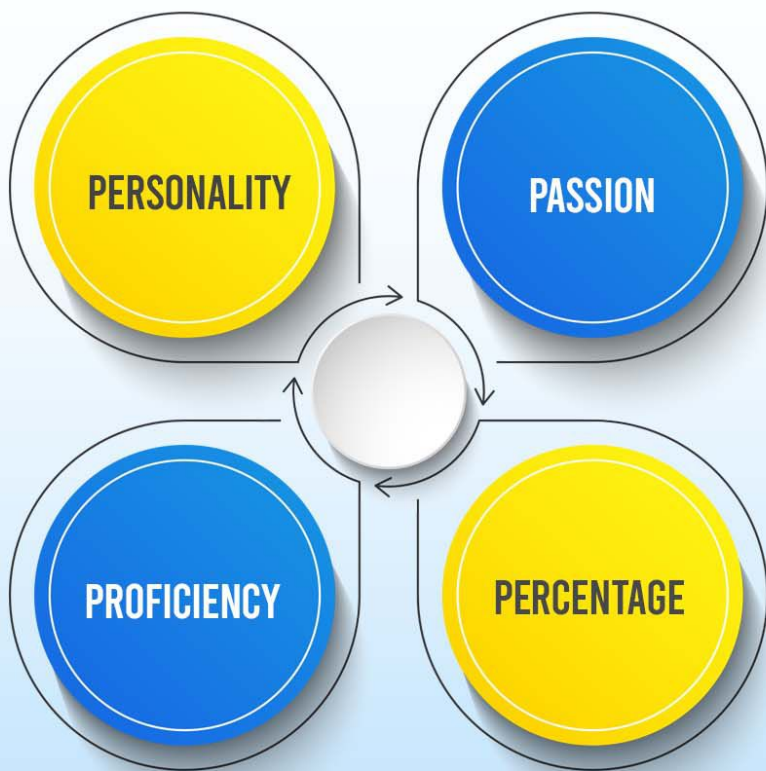

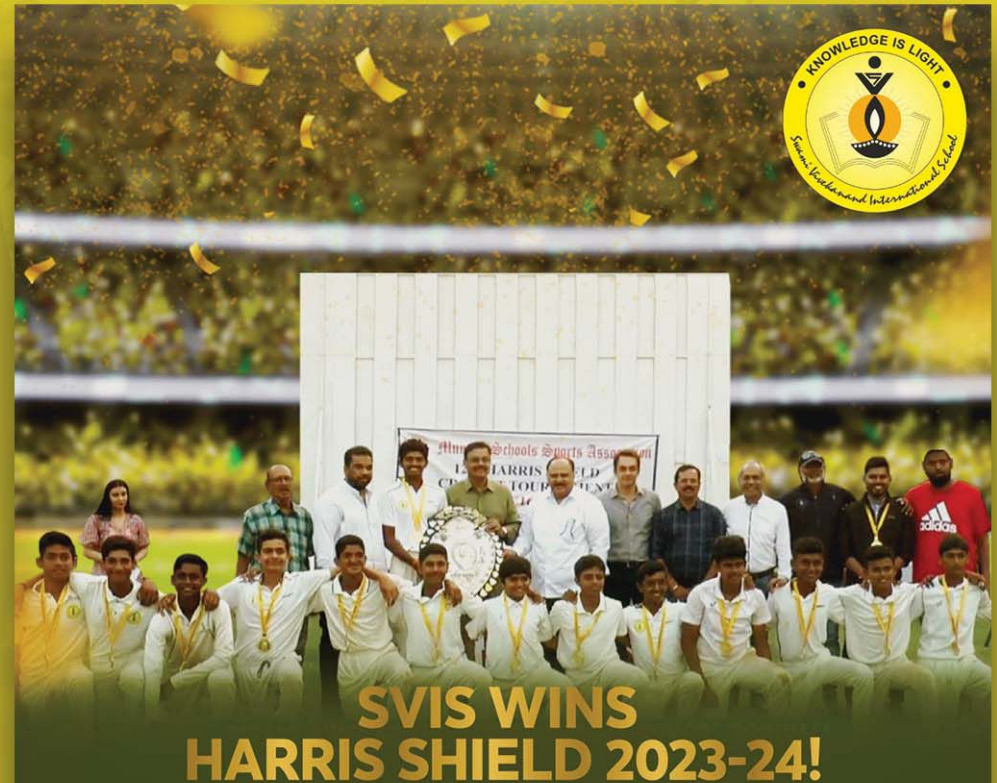
Pune sweep tennis titles at State Olympic Games

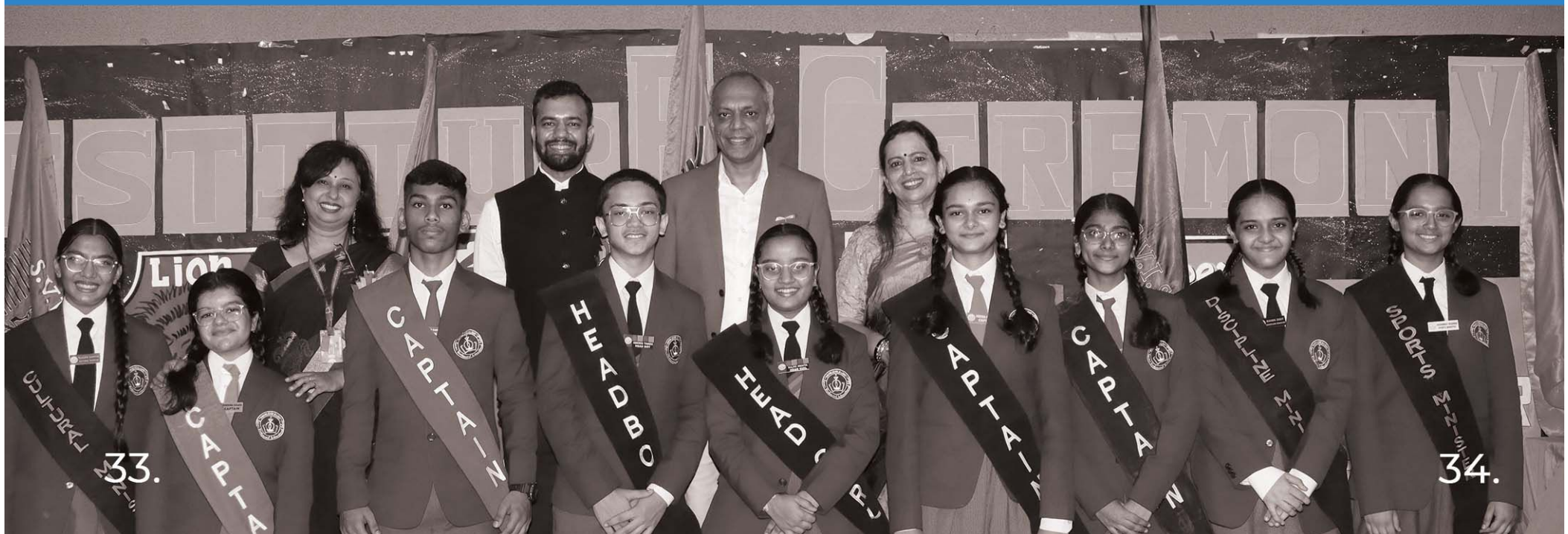

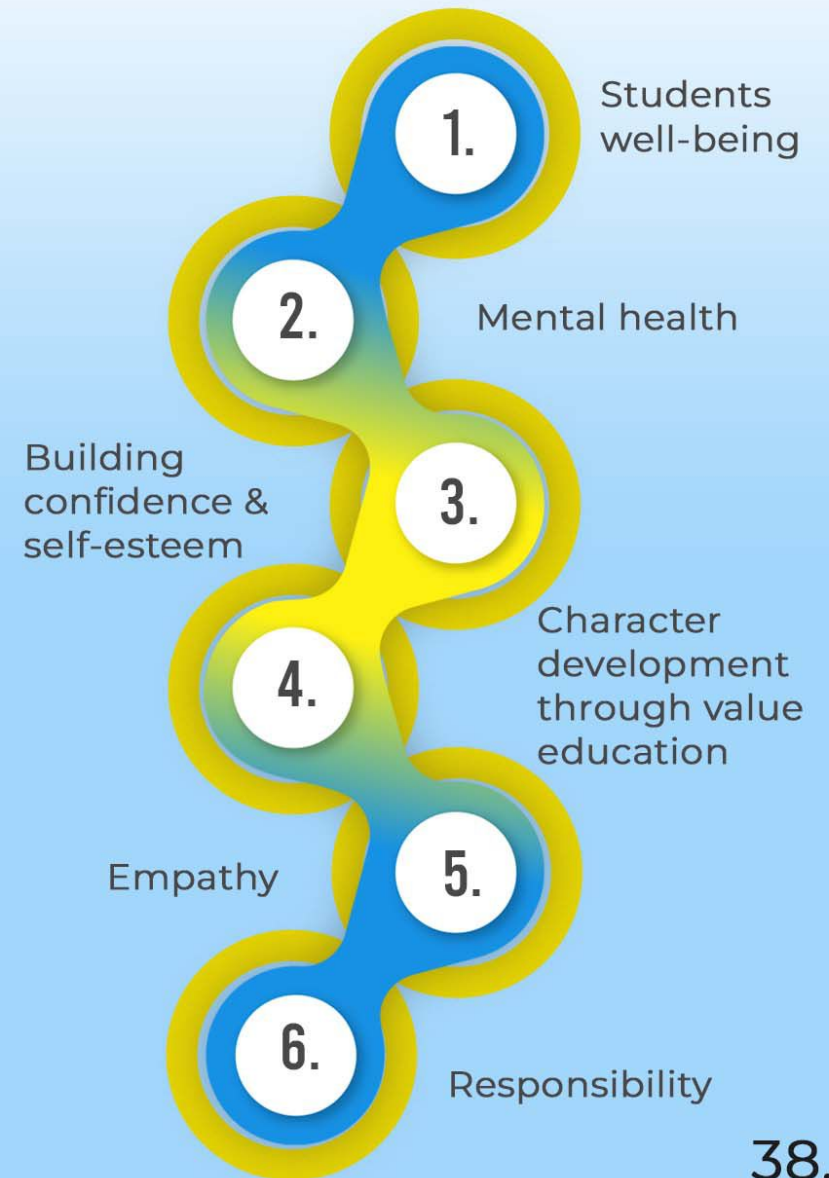
